3.3 GPA Appeal Criteria	Required Documents
<b>Disability</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Documentation of students disability</li> </ul>
<b>Serious illness or injury of student</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Note from physician</li> </ul>
<b>Pregnancy or adoption</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Documentation/note from a physician</li> </ul>
<b>Serious illness/death of immediate family</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Note from physician or death certificate</li> </ul>
<b>Other serious personal difficulties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Appropriate supporting documentation/Note from advisor, psychologist, social worker, etc.</li> </ul>
<b>Fulfillment of military service</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Documentation of military orders</li> </ul>
<b>Extreme financial hardship</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A statement from the student describing fully the reason(s) for the appeal</li> <li>• Student and spouse/parent (if dependent) 2020 and 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript or 1040 Signed Federal Tax Return, and W2 forms</li> <li>• Documentation of student and spouse/parent expected 2022 income (Copies of pay stubs, unemployment benefits, and other untaxed income)</li> <li>• Supporting documentation that details financial hardship, such as:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>o Written notice of involuntary job termination or layoff</li> <li>o Copies of severance pay or any benefits</li> <li>o Loss of child support</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
