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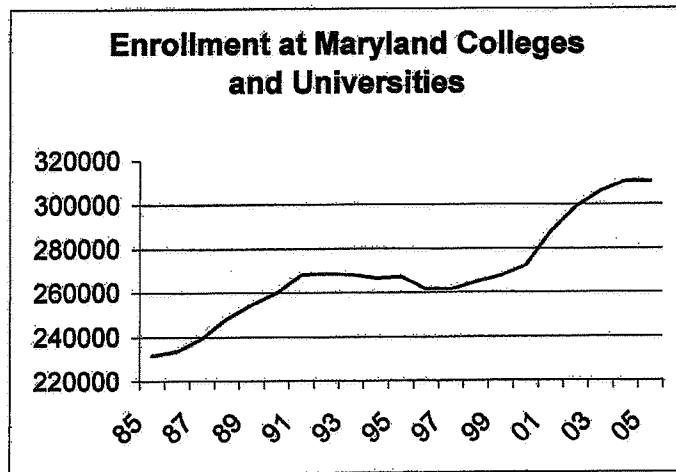
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Maryland Higher Education Enrollment Remains Steady

The following report highlights enrollment data submitted by the State's colleges and universities. Final numbers may vary slightly due to students enrolling or dropping out by November 15, the last date on which 2005 enrollment figures are reported to the Maryland Higher Education Commission



- Total headcount enrollment at Maryland's colleges and universities remained steady from last year. The total headcount of 310,441 students is virtually unchanged from last year's total headcount of 310,482.
- During the past 20 years, total enrollment in Maryland has grown by 34 percent.
- Independent colleges and universities experienced the most growth of any higher education sector, increasing total enrollment by 1.9 percent. Enrollments at Maryland community colleges were virtually flat, rising by only 150 students. Public four-year institutions lost 0.9 percent of their enrollment. Total enrollment for the University System of Maryland decreased slightly from 128,806 to 128,052 (or

0.6 percent) this year. Total enrollment at Morgan State University decreased by 474 students or 6.9 percent. This is the largest one-year drop for Morgan since 1984. Enrollment at St. Mary's College of Maryland increased by 1.5 percent.

- Full-time undergraduate enrollment increased statewide by 1.3 percent. Full-time undergraduate enrollment increased in all sectors: at community colleges (1.8 percent), public four-year institutions (0.6 percent) and independent institutions (2.6 percent). The number of full-time undergraduates has grown for 12 consecutive years – by 32.7 percent.
- For the first time in five years, part-time undergraduate enrollment decreased by 2.3 percent overall. This was due primarily to a drop of 7.1 percent among part-time students at the public four-year campuses. Part-time undergraduate enrollment dropped by 0.8 percent at the community colleges and by 0.4 percent at independent colleges and universities.
- First-time, full-time enrollment remained level. This fall Maryland's institutions reported 35,192 first-time, full-time students. First-time, full-time enrollment increased by 3.7 percent at Maryland independent institutions, but declined by 1 percent at the

community colleges and public four-year institutions. First-time, full-time enrollment at Morgan State University plummeted by 42.8 percent.

- Full and part-time graduate and professional enrollments surpassed last year's record highs, driven by an increase in full-time students. The number of part-time graduate and professional students stayed almost the same, while full-time enrollments increased by 3.0 percent. This is the ninth straight year of growth for graduate and professional enrollments.
- Undergraduate enrollment increased at six of the thirteen public four-year colleges and universities: Coppin, Salisbury, Towson, University of Maryland College Park, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, and St. Mary's. University of Maryland University College reported the largest numerical drop: 1,321. This is the first undergraduate enrollment decline at UMUC since 1997.
- Nine of the sixteen community colleges increased total headcount. Anne Arundel increased by the most students: 208 for a 1.4 percent gain. The highest percentage increase occurred at Cecil Community College (7.6 percent and 135 students). Enrollments also increased at Carroll, Southern Maryland, Frederick, Garrett, Harford, Howard and Montgomery. Enrollments dropped at two Baltimore-area colleges: Community College of Baltimore County (1.7 percent) and Baltimore City Community College (2.5 percent).
- The Johns Hopkins University experienced the greatest increase in undergraduates among independent institutions: 316 students or 5.5 percent. Hagerstown Business College also experienced significant growth with an increase of 193 students or 21.3 percent. These two institutions represented more than half of the yearly undergraduate growth in the independent sector.
- Women continued to outnumber men at Maryland colleges and universities, representing 59.6 percent of all students.
